



KING LOUIE FIELD HOCKEY LEAGUE RULES

Official Rules of Play

Unless otherwise stated, the Rules of Hockey will govern play. The following tournament rules, and/or modifications to the Rules of Play, will be in effect for all divisions of play in the King Louie field hockey leagues.

DURATION OF PLAY:

50 minute games.

PACE OF PLAY:

- Running clock. No Time Outs. No injury stoppage.
- Penalty comers or penalty strokes awarded before the end of the game will be completed only if it will impact the outcome of the game.
- MERCY RULE: Game stoppage occurs when one team has established a 10-point margin.

SCORING:

Win = 3 points

Tie = 1point

Shut Out = 1 point

Goals – 1 point per goal scored up to 4 in each game

Total possible points per game = 8 points

TIES: If there is a Tie for FIRST place in the pools, the order of breaking the Tie will be:

- Head-to-head winner
- Goal Differential (goals scored minus goals against)
- Total goals scored
- Goals against
- Coin Toss

PENALTIES:

Any player receiving a red card in a game is suspended from the remainder of the game in which the offense occurred **and** the team's next scheduled game. Referees will notify the Director of any red card issued immediately after the game in which it was issued.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: Snow/Ice

1. If a game is cancelled to weather King Louie will do our best to reschedule the game ASAP.
2. King Louie reserves the right to modify the to game schedule, duration of games, rules governing pool play, standings, etc. in the event of inclement weather.
